# \*Individual sounds (phonemes)

- \*Phonetic transcription: Yes, or no?
- precise immitation of a sound
- confidence in speaking production
- + easier decoding in many words
- children learn both sound and written form
- too complicated to teach
- !!! early start
  !!! but only in a receptive way!

We should never ask children to WRITE transcription of words!


- \*dividing speech into comprehensible chunks

- \*later recognition of words (dyslexics)









- \*Comprehension in a stream of speech
- \*Stress = MEANING (nouns, adjectives, full verbs etc.)
- \*Unstressed words = grammar and linking words (auxiliaries, prepositions, pronouns, articles)
- \*EVERYTHING WHAT IS STRESSED IS IMPORTANT


