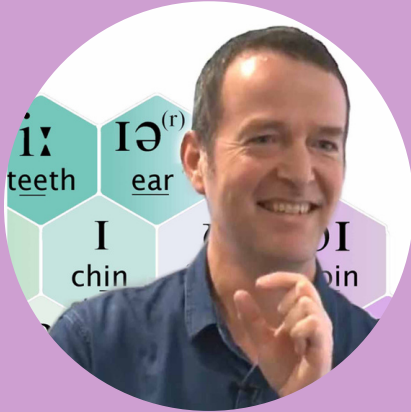

Making Pronunciation Activities: Tricks and Traps

After several decades of creating and publishing pronunciation materials, Mark has learnt a few tricks of the trade.
