## Understanding Intelligibility in Pronunciation Instruction

This presentation discusses pronunciation instruction in light of seminal studies on intelligibility (Jenkins, 2000) and reflective teaching (Munro and Derwing, 2006; Levis, McCrocklin, 2018). It will discuss the contributions of a communicative teaching framework for pronunciation (Celce-Murcia, 2010) whilst considering fundamental concepts in phonetics and phonology (Thomson, 2018, Walker, 2015). These ideas intend to provide ELT professionals with access to various resources and tools to help them be<mark>come</mark> (even more) aware of what they need to consider when they have to teach pronunciation in their classrooms.
